

## **HEALTH & SAFETY FOR MUSIC BEES SESSIONS | FOR PARENTS & GUARDIANS**

The aim of Music Bees classes, with your help, is to create a safe, nurturing environment in which to give your child/ren an interactive, positive & fun musical experience.

### **HEALTH & SAFETY**

By enrolling in **Music Bees**, you are agreeing to assume responsibility for the safety of your child at all times. Whilst all care & consideration is taken to ensure a safe environment is provided, we do not assume health & safety for your family.

- Small props & instruments are used in the class which may contain small parts. It's not recommended to allow your child to put these toys or instruments in their mouths.
- Please ensure you only take photographs of your own children in the class
- Please turn off or silence your mobile phone for the duration of the class.

### **COVID-19 SYMPTOMS & OTHER ILLNESSES**

PLEASE do not bring your child to class if you or your child are displaying any of the following symptoms:

- High temperature of over 38.0 deg C
- New continuous cough
- Loss of taste/smell
- Headache, dizziness,
- Diarrhoea & vomiting
- Chicken Pox / measles symptoms

Please inform me if you or your child has any of the above Covid-19 symptoms. You will not be permitted to attend Music Bees for two weeks. Please go to [www.gov.uk](http://www.gov.uk) for more information.

Please do not return to class until symptoms of chicken pox have disappeared.

**\*Please take yourself and your child's temperature on the morning of the class.**

### **ADJUSTING TO THE NEW NORMAL IN CLASS**

Here are some things to keep everyone safe and reassured as we restart Music Bees:

- Only one parent/carer per child. No siblings allowed, unless with prior agreement
- Please arrive no more than 5 minutes before the class and wait outside to be called in
- Staggered session start times with 15 minutes between each class
- There will be no toys or instruments to explore at the beginning of the class
- Please keep 2m distance from other participants & your child safely with you on your mat/blanket
- Ensure you & your child's belongings are kept to a minimum & safely out of reach of others
- Please ensure you & your child arrive & leave the session being mindful of others
- Hand sanitiser & wipes will be available

### **INSTRUMENTS & EQUIPMENT**

- Each child will be given their own individual bag with all the items they will need for the session in the bag. All items would have been thoroughly cleaned using hot water & detergent or wipes & disinfectant spray before being put into the bag. Please put everything back into the bag after the session
- All scarves & bags will be washed in the washing machine with anti-bacterial wash after each session
- All instruments & props will be thoroughly cleaned after each session
- Please advise if there is an issue with any of your instruments & props
- Please let me know if any of your instruments & props are touched by another child
- Wipes will be available should you wish to wipe down your instruments/bags during the session

### **WHAT YOU NEED TO DO & BRING ALONG FOR EACH SESSION**

- Check your temperature and that of your child on morning of the session
- Bring your own hand sanitiser (keep safely away from children) to use before & during session
- Your own blanket / yoga mat to sit on on
- Your child's own cuddly toy of choice to use in the class
- Your singing voice and a smile!

### **VENUE**

- Please ensure you follow social distancing rules within the venue and observe entrance & exit signs.
- Toilets & baby change are available and are used at your own risk. Please take nappies home.
- Please bring buggies into the hall.
- Once the session has finished. please leave the hall as soon as possible.
- Limited parking available in front of church & on surrounding roads

### **PAYMENT**

- Your place in the session is reserved once payment has been received.
- Payment is for 6 sessions within the term. These credits cannot be rolled over to the next term
- If there is another suitable class with availability you made attend this to make up a missed session.
- No refunds can be given. Thanks you for your understanding
- If the session is cancelled due to lockdown or teacher illness, credits will be rolled over to the next session.
