

The Tiny Reset Baby Massage Course – Terms and Conditions

1. Introduction

These Terms and Conditions govern participation in The Tiny Reset Baby Massage Course ("the Course"). By booking and attending the Course, you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

2. Booking and Payment

- Full payment is required to secure your place on the Course unless otherwise agreed.
- Places are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Booking confirmation will be provided upon receipt of payment.
- All course fees are quoted in GBP (£) and are subject to change without notice for future bookings.

3. Cancellations and Refunds

Participant Cancellations

- Cancellations made more than 14 days before the course start date will receive a full refund.
- Cancellations made within 14 days of the course start date are non-refundable unless exceptional circumstances apply at the discretion of The Tiny Reset.
- If you are unable to attend a session, refunds will not be provided for missed classes.

Course Cancellations

- The Tiny Reset reserves the right to cancel or reschedule a course due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient bookings, illness, or events beyond our control.
- In such cases, participants will be offered an alternative date or a full refund.

4. Health and Wellbeing

- Parents or carers are responsible for ensuring that they and their baby are medically fit to participate.
- Baby massage should not be performed if a baby is unwell, has a fever, contagious illness, or any condition for which massage is not advised.

- If you have concerns about your baby's health, you should seek advice from a qualified healthcare professional before attending.
- Participation is voluntary, and parents/carers should always follow their baby's cues and comfort levels during sessions.

5. Parent/Carer Responsibility

- Parents or carers remain solely responsible for the supervision, care, and safety of their baby at all times during the Course.
- The Tiny Reset does not provide childcare services.
- Participants are expected to behave respectfully towards other attendees and the instructor.

6. Liability

- While every effort is made to provide a safe and supportive environment, participation in the Course is at your own risk.
- The Tiny Reset shall not be liable for any injury, loss, damage, expense, or claim arising from participation in the Course except where caused by negligence or where liability cannot legally be excluded.
- Nothing in these Terms and Conditions limits any statutory rights you may have under applicable law.
