We care about your privacy and the privacy of your child(ren). This page explains clearly how we collect, use, and protect your information when you book classes, attend events, or interact with us online.

Why We Collect Your Information

We need some details from you so we can:

- Make sure your child is in the right age
- Confirm your bookings and remind you of upcoming events
- Keep everyone safe and meet insurance or safeguarding requirements
- Let you know about our other classes, tips, or special offers if you choose to opt-in

What we collect:

- Your name, email, phone number via your Happity booking form
- Your child(ren)'s name, date of birth, and gender
- Any health or medical information you provide
- Booking history and class attendance
- Payment information for verification (we don't keep your card details)

We only collect what we need to run safe, fun, and smooth events

Children's Data & Parental Consent

If your child is under 13, we rely on your consent as a parent or guardian to process their data. You're responsible for making sure the information you provide about your child is accurate.

Marketing & Communications

We'd love to keep you informed about:

- Rebooking reminders for full events or waiting lists
- Offers, tips, or news about our events

Who We Share Your Information With

We work with trusted partners to make things run smoothly, like:

- Payment processors
- Website hosts and analytics providers
- Our booking system provider
- Our venue

These partners follow strict rules and can't use your data for anything else.

How Long We Keep Your Information

We keep your data only as long as we need to:

- Booking and attendance information: 3 years after your last class (for insurance and legal reasons)
- Marketing information: Until you withdraw consent

After that, your information is securely deleted.

Your Rights

You have rights under UK GDPR. You can:

- Ask for a copy of the data we hold
- Ask us to correct any mistakes
- Ask us to delete your data
- Object to how we use your data (including marketing)
- Ask us to restrict processing or move your data elsewhere
- Withdraw your consent at any time
- Complain to the ICO if you feel we're not handling your data properly.

Keeping Your Data Safe

In the rare event of a data breach, we will follow UK GDPR rules, notify the ICO if necessary, and let anyone affected know promptly.
